R. Kook

- Abraham Isaac Kook (1865–1935)
- > The Vision of Vegetarianism and Peace
 - > vegetarianism as a moral credo is best solely as an idea, but not as a practice or norm.
 - Other societal ills on which to focus
 - > equating man and animal may lead to man acting like an animal.

R. Soloveitchik

- > believed all life, even animal life is sanctified.
- G-d gave into man's desires and let him eat meat.
- > Deut 12:20
- > Radically different view than predecessors

Gary Yourofsky

- Human life is not valuable...people are not special" *Israeli Interview Dec 2013*
- > Offended that the Jewish Holocaust is compared to the Animal Holocaust (a greater atrocity). *i24**news*
- > Peace will come through vegan lifestyles

podcast points

- Man's "stealing" from the animals contributes to the G-d's decision to "reboot".
- > People who refrain from eating meat evolve into people who respect life.
- During the Reign of Messiah, we will be vegetarians.

what's the beef

- > Is killing animals *murder* (i.e. is killing animals morally wrong)?
- Does G-d command us to kill animals?
- Does G-d command us to eat the flesh of animals?
- Did G-d ever eat meat?
- > What is the risk of abstaining from all animal products on the grounds of morality.

...however

- > Is it godly to mistreat animals?
 - > Shabbat (Ex 20:10)
 - Muzzling (Deut 25:4)
 - > Prevent suffering (Deut 22:10, Deut 22:4, Lev 22:28, Deut 22:6-7)
- > What should our halacha consider?
